Herman, a Jewish American sailor, writes his mother in the United States:

"JULY 3- 1945 -

I AM ON WATCH TONIGHT SO WILLWRITE YOU A FEW LINES I HAVE RECEIVED SEVERAL LETTERS FROM YOU LATELY BUT JUST HAVEN'T GOTTEN AROUND TO WRITTING.

AM GLAD YOU GOT THE PICTURE OK, I THOUGHT I CAME OUT PRETTY GOOD TOO. THAT IS QUITE A BEARD THAT GUY HAS ISN'T IT- SEVERAL OF THE GUYS ON THE SHIP HAVE THEM.

THAT CLIPPING YOU SENT ME ABOUT THAT DESTROYER ISN'T MY SHIPX. IT IS AN ENTIRELY DIFFERENT ONE THAN THIS ONE THAT IS A PRETTY OLD SHIP, AND THIS ONE WAS A BRAND NEW ONE WHEN I GOT ON IT.

I RECEIVED ONE OF THE POST THE OTHER DAY THE ONE WITH THE PAPER IN, THANKS A LOT. I'VE HAD A COUPLE OF LETTERS FROM SARA IAM WONDERING IF SHE IS BACK HOME YET I GUESS SHE IS BY NOW TELL HER I WILL WRITE HER SOON. I GOT A LETTER FROM MRS. BENIS THE OTHER DAY SHE SENT ME THE PROGRAM OF THE GRADUATION...SHE ALSO SAID HER SON WAS LEAVING SOON TOO.

I DON'T KNOW ANY THING NEW EVERY THING IS ABOUT THE SAME WITH ME. IAM FINE SO DON'T WORRY ABOUT ME, I HOPE YOU ARE FEELING OK TOO..

I HAVE BEEN OVER ONE THE BEACH A COUPLE OF TIMES I HAD AFEW BEERS AND COKES, THEY HAVE THIS PLACE FIXED UP PRETTY GOOD HERE, THEY HAVE A CANTEEN WHERE YOU CAN BUY COFFEE, ETC.

I MET A FRIEND TODAY HE IS ONE OF THE KIDS THAT WENT TO SCHOOL WITH, HE IS ON A DESTROYER ALSO.

YOU ASKED WHERE THEY POST MARK THE LETTERS, I REALLY DON'T KNOW BUT I GUESS THEY DO IT AT THE F.P.O I N FRISCO...

...I ALSO HAD A LETTER FROM KEN HE IS ON ANOTHER SHIP NOW I DON'T KNOW HOW

HE DOES IT BUT HE SURE GETS AROUND, HE IS ON AN S.C. NOW...

...I GOT SO MANY LETTERS TO WRITE I DON'T KNOW IF I WILL EVER GET THEM DONE OR NOT,

WELL MOM I GUESS I HAD BETTER CLOSE FOR THIS TIME BUT WILL WRITE AGAIN SOON, IM FINE HOPE YOU ALL ARE TO, TELL EVERY ONE HELLO . BYE NOW
